

**THE ORGANISERS** The 2018 LGBTIQ Women's Health Conference on July 12-13 is organised by Thorne Harbour Health in partnership with ACON.

**CONFERENCE LOCATION** The 2018 LGBTIQ Women's Health Conference will take place at the Jasper Hotel, 489 Elizabeth Street Melbourne 3000.

**MEDIA ACCESS** All conference participants will be issued with passes during registration. Accredited media are required to wear their press badges at all times. Media accreditation includes entry to all conference sessions and workshops.

A conference bag and conference materials are also included. All conference bags will be distributed on site on the day of registration.

Members of the media may be asked to respect the anonymity of delegates and speakers at some sessions deemed by participants to be a sensitive and/or personal nature. Filming (video or photography) may be restricted/prohibited at these sessions.

**SAFETY & INCLUSION** Safety and inclusion are central to the physical and online conference space. LGBTIQ WHC invites participants to approach the conference and other delegates with openness and thoughtfulness regarding other people's knowledge, experience and identities.

**EMBARGO POLICY** Information and resources supplied to media delegates are released under a strict embargo policy. If press releases or other information is marked as being under an embargo, we ask that members of the media respect this policy. Failure to comply may result in accreditation being withdrawn.

**MEDIA CENTRE** The Media Centre is located on Level 1 of the conference centre at the Jasper Hotel. It is equipped with a wireless network (wi-fi) and power boards. Wi-fi login details are:

Due to the sensitive nature of some sessions and workshops, chairs may impose further restrictions on visual recording at their discretion.
